**i. October Disability Employment Awareness Month**

Hosting a reverse job fair October 7<sup>th</sup>. The event is being finalized and instructions on how to register will be shared through social media and other avenues. They are looking for food donations for the employers. Approximately 20 employers/20 job seekers. They would also like to host a morning session in March. The employers need to be in Fishers but job seekers do not have to be from Fishers. They are also looking at restarting the business network group.

**d. Community Supports & Services – Kelly Hartman**

- i. Indiana State Transition Plan will become effective on March 17, 2023 and will impact all services.
- ii. The State Legislative session is a budget session, a lot of issues coming up in session. Get involved and advocate!
